## EXTRAORDINARY MEETING

DRAFT MINUTES FOR APPROVAL AT NEXT MEETING

Minutes of an Extraordinary Meeting of Barnack Parish Council held in the Village Hall, Barnack, on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> July at 7pm.

### 1) ATTENDANCE

- a) In attendance – *Chair: Harry Brassey (HB), Vice-Chair: Margaret Palmer (MP), Councillors: Ivor Crowson (IC), Phil Broughton (PB), David Laycock (DL), Ward Councillor David Over (DO) and three residents.*
- b) Apologies for absence accepted from – *Councillors Sophie Moore (SM) and Martin Bloom (MB).*

### 2) DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST AND DISPENSATIONS – *No declarations were made.*

### 3) OPEN FORUM – *Open Forum was held during item 4a of the Agenda.*

*Concerns were raised about planning application 17/01087/FUL, and the plans for the landowner to open a rabbit farm. These included smell, drainage and water pollution, increased transport on Uffington Road (with access to and from the site on a blind bend), unclear environmental management, unclear use of buildings (will there be meat processing on site?) and attracting vermin to the area.*

### 4) PLANNING

- a) 17/01087/FUL - Erection of temporary timber dwelling and agricultural building, Land to the West of Uffington Road, Barnack. *It was agreed by unanimous vote that BPC would submit a letter of objection to the application and request that it be referred to the Planning Committee. MP read out a draft letter of objection with minor amendments discussed and agreed. Action – MP & Clerk.*

### 5) CORRESPONDENCE

- a) Debra Martin, Party in the Paddock. *In 2012 the Barnack Horticultural Show raised £1000 to be donated to the Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) Project. Due to the current absence of a site for the MUGA, it was agreed by unanimous vote that the money would be redirected back into the newly resurrected Horticultural Show and Party in the Paddock.*

### 6) OTHER ITEMS

- a) Vehicle Activated Signs. *Quotes from Swarco, Unipart Dorman and Westcotec were circulated, with Swarco and Westcotec able to provide the variety of signs requested. HB will look into the warranty details of both Swarco and Westcotec and report back at the next Parish Council Meeting. Action – HB.*
- b) School Grounds Security. *The Chair of the School Governors wrote to BPC to request all reports of disturbances be emailed to Foundation Governor Mike Mills (mills.mh@gmail.com) and not the School Office. The Clerk will source quotes for temporary signs to display the rules for use of the Playing Field. This item will be carried over to the next Parish Council Meeting. Action – HB & Clerk.*
