## Proposed Gladman Development in Barnack

I have been asked by the Council, on behalf of the village residents, to write and express its serious concerns and disappointment over the proposed housing development on your land, west of Uffington Road, Barnack.

The village had a very well attended public meeting recently, with a strong representation of views which illustrated the depth of feeling against this proposal.

The Council has sent a letter listing the objections of village residents to the Peterborough City Council Planning Department and the main items of concern are:

1. The proposed development is outside the Village Envelope.
2. Barnack is classed as a Limited Growth Village.
3. The landscape will be irrevocably changed, especially the approaches from the north and the west.
4. The character of the village will be changed forever.
5. The increased burden on local infrastructure is not sustainable.

Please find enclosed a copy of our formal objection letter.

If this development goes ahead it will sadly change the village out of all recognition and have a detrimental effect on the lives of the community, many of whom put in so much time and effort to help conserve the unique features of the village.

We know that you and your family have enjoyed a long standing connection and bond with our village and under the circumstances we ask you and your advisers to please reconsider your proposals to ensure that Barnack maintains its unique characteristics, not only for its present residents but also for generations to come. I do hope you do not mind us writing to you personally but we did want to advise you of our deep felt concerns about the proposed development amongst our community.
