Service 201/202 runs between Bourne and Peterborough, via Stamford, Barnack and Helpston. Buses run approximately hourly in both directions, from early morning until early evening. ### **CallConnect**

This is an on-demand minibus service covering the Stamford and Peterborough area. It is funded by several local authorities, including Peterborough City Council. There is no fixed timetable and the route is defined by passenger demand. Concessionary bus passes are valid. The minibus picks up and sets down at designated places, but in certain circumstances will collect people from their homes.

You need to register for membership before booking.
