#### 3) PLANNING: 2 x Planning applications for tree works:

- a) 20/01710/CTR The Millstone Inn Millstone Lane Barnack remove leylandii and other trees as part of pub reconstruction works *No objections*
- b) 20/01711/CTR St John The Baptist Church Main Street Barnack reduce height of sycamore to remove obstruction to street lighting *Branches to be removed are from side, not top of tree. Overall height should not be impacted except to ensure tree is not lopsided.*

#### 4) COVID grant expenditure

- a) Provision of Chromebooks to children at Barnack School to assist with lockdown learning. *Use of the COVID grant money was approved to buy 25 Chrome Books for use by children at Barnack school for home learning during lockdown.*
